FURTHER ORDERED that the relator may now serve the Complaint, the declination notice filed by the Commonwealth, this Order, and all other papers filed after the date of this

Order; all other papers which were previously filed under seal in this action prior to the date of this Order shall remain sealed; and it is,

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall issue Summonses to be served by Counsel for the Relator; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to Virginia Code §8.01-216.8, the parties shall serve the Attorney General for the Commonwealth with a copy of all pleadings, motions, discovery, and other items exchanged by the parties in this civil action.


